It's 2050 and Cambridge has changed...

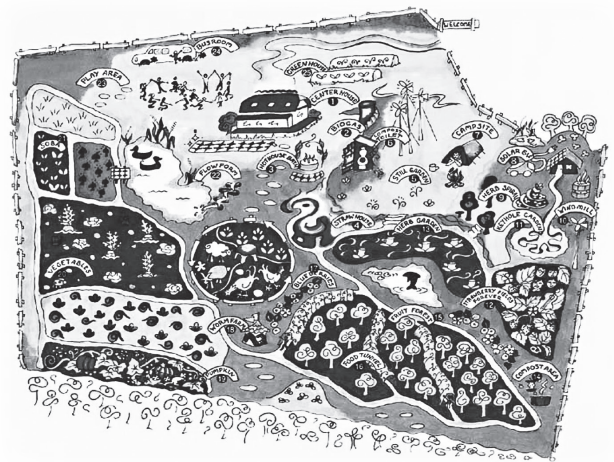
