We need donations of the following plants, which we know grow well in Cherry Hinton soil: Agapanthus, Agastache, Aster, Bergenia (Elephant's ears), Campanula, Coreopsis, Crocosmia, Echinacea, Geranium, Geum, Helenium, Hellebores, Hemerocallis, Nepet, Paeonia, Penstemon, Potentilla, Salvia, Sedum, Solidago, Verbena, Viola

If you can donate any of these from your garden, please dig some up, remove any weeds, pop in a pot, box or bag with a little soil or wet newspapers over the roots, and label with name if known, and colour. Bring to the garden on Wednesday 28th February, 11am-1pm!
